

# **FBCL Regathering Guide:** Safety Information For Worship

Please read carefully about the safety protocols we have put in place as we regather for worship. We are asking for everyone's cooperation as we open safely to gather again for in-person worship. Thank you for being extra careful as we strive to be together again and do it with the utmost safety to protect each other.

# Before you leave home -

- 1. Please take your temperature before you leave home to come to the church. If it is higher than normal, please stay home.
- 2. If you are feeling ill, please stay home.
- 3. If you know you have been exposed to COVID-19, please be responsible and stay home.
- 4. Bring your own Bible and writing utensil if you will need one.
- 5. Did you remember your mask?



# Arriving at church and before you come into the building -


- 1. All participants will need to enter at the ramp door on the back side of the building.
- 2. Please make sure to keep a good distance from others as you enter the building.
- 3. And, do you have your mask on?

# As you enter the building and prepare to enter the sanctuary -

- 1. You will be greeted at ramp door entrance with a friendly smile You just won't see it because it will be hidden under a mask. :)
- 2. They will be asking you a series of short questions. They will be:
  - a. What is your name and are you feeling well today?
  - b. If you are not wearing a mask, they will ask if you have one and if you can please put it on. If you do not have a mask, we will provide one for you.
  - c. How many will be in your group/family? (seating purposes)
- 3. You will be given a seating assignment and then you will enter the sanctuary.
- 4. No childcare will be provided at this time. Children will need to remain with their parents at all times during the service.



#### In the Sanctuary -



- 2. In your pew you will find a six foot piece of pvc pipe. This will be used to help with safe distancing of families sitting in the same row. This will be explained at the time of the service to you.
- 3. You will notice that all of the Bibles and hymnals have been removed from the pew racks. All songs and announcements will be viewed on screen.
- 4. Please refrain from removing your mask during the service.
- 5. Music The praise team will be leading us in worship but please refrain from removing your mask to sing. You can hum along or sing under your mask.

#### Conclusion of the Service -

- When the service has completed, we will dismiss you by rows to safely exit the sanctuary.
- 2. Please exit the sanctuary and the building via the ramp doors.
- 3. Feel free to catch up with friends in the parking lot as you continue to keep safe distancing.

### **Restrooms?**

- 1. If you need to use the restroom, you will be directed out the double doors on the bell tower side to use the restrooms in the connecting hallway.
- 2. Do not go outside to use the bathrooms. There are no bathrooms outside. Go right and then left into the hallway off the Narthex to use the Gent's or Ladies' rooms.
- 3. Only one person can use the restroom at a time. When you come to the restroom door please knock and check before entering.
- 4. Please wash your hands before exiting the restrooms and use a paper towel to pull open the door.



# Other areas of the Church -

You will notice there will be signs posted and caution tape placed near the rear of the sanctuary and in the hallways. Please be mindful that we are trying to restrict traffic to only areas that are needed to be used during the worship service. The Narthex, Judson Hall area, upstairs will all be off limits for the time being to minimize traffic areas we need to clean.
